EXHIBIT "A"

TRACT A

All that certain 58 151 acre tract of land in Blocks #5 and #6 of the James Clark Survey, Abstract 172, Cass County, Texas, Being all of the same land described in a Warranty Deed from Derrell McCoy and wife to Ben A Hap, St. dated May 22, 1973 and recorded in Volume 554 on Page 688,

BEGINNING at an old 1 1/22 iron pipe in the North line of the John W Duncan Survey, Abstract 262 and the South line of the Clark Survey and on the Southwest corner of Block 5 for an angle point in the South line of this described tract, the Southeast corner of Block 6;

THENCE South 85 34/51 West, along the South line of the Clark Survey as occupied, at 16 47 feet pass an iron rod on the Northeast corner of the Marvin Coleman Tract, a total distance of 334 26 feet to an old 1 1/2" Iron pipe in the Northeast right of way line of Texas Farm Road No 125 for the Southwest corner, the Northwest corner of the Coleman Tract. THENCE North 89° 34' 51" East, 20 feet from and parallel to the South line of the Clark Survey, 355 07 feet to an iron rod in the East line of Block 6 and the West line of Block 5 for an ell corner,

THENCE North 00° 16' 40" West along a marked line, at 1834 96 feet pass 0 83 feet East of a 1" pipe, a total distance of 2043 64 feet to an old 1/2" fron pipe on the South side of an old abandoned County Road for the Northwest corner A Red Oak marked "X", been South 33° East, 24 0 feet, a Pine marked "X" bears South 53° West 18 7 feet,

THENCE North 89° 02' 53" West along the marked survey line, 2196 89 feet to the Place of Beginning

All that certain 38333 acre tract of land in the James Clark Survey, Abstract 172, Cass County, Texas. Being the remaining portion of a called 65.80 acre tract described in Volume 535, Page 12, Cass County Deed Records and being more particularly described by metes and bounds as follows:

Beginning at: A 2" from pipe found for the Northeast corner of said 38.492 acre tract, pipe also the Northeast corner of original called 65.80 acres, pipe also the Southeast corner of a 1.00 acre tract;

Thence: Along an old-marked lipe, S 00° 41' 04" E, 1833.69 ft. to a 1/2" rebar set for the Southeast corner of said 38.333 acres, pipe also the Northeast corner of a called 0.16 acre tract described in Volume 473, Page 36 and Volume 535, Page 131
