Carbon Monoxide and Smoke Detector/Alarm Disclosure

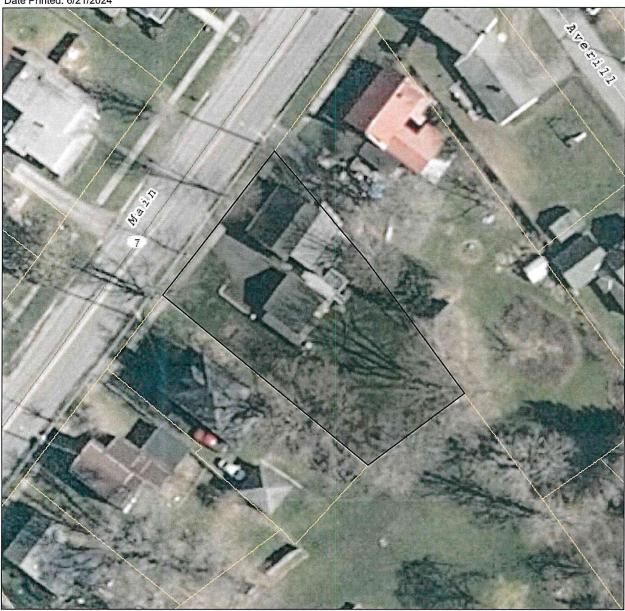
