THENCE along the line common to this 0.224 acres and said West 0.25 acres, South 59 degrees 09 minutes 07 seconds West (called South 60 degrees 00 minutes 00 seconds West) a distance of 150.26 feet to a point for the South corner of this 0.224 acres, which bears North 61 degrees 40 minutes 38 seconds East, 0.58 feet from a found 1/2-inch iron rod, and bears South 77 degrees 33 minutes 49 seconds East, 0.29 feet from the center of a wooden fence post, same being the West corner of said West 0.25 acres and on the northeast Right-of-Way of S. 2nd St.;

THENCE along the northeast Right-of-Way of said S. 2nd St., North 30 degrees 44 minutes 48 seconds West (called North 29 degrees 53 minutes 55 seconds West), a distance of 59.92 feet to a 1/2-inch iron rod found for the West corner of this 0.224 acres, same being the South corner of the Oscar Cisneros 0.0999 acres (Volume 906, Page 419);

THENCE along the lines common to this 0.224 acres and said Cisneros 0.0999 acres, the following courses and distances:

North 59 degrees 08 minutes 15 seconds East (called North 59 degrees 59 minutes 08 seconds East), a distance of 74.84 feet to a point for an angle corner, which bears South 38 degrees 31 minutes 43 seconds West, 0.50 feet from the center of a wooden fence post;

North 30 degrees 07 minutes 31 seconds West (called North 29 degrees 16 minutes 38 seconds West), a distance of 10.25 feet to a 1/2-inch iron rod found for an angle corner, same being the South corner of the Israel Jimenez 0.12 acres (Volume 1501, Page 244);

THENCE along the line common to this 0.224 acres and said Jimenez 0.12 acres, North 59 degrees 14 minutes 08 seconds East (called North 60 degrees 05 minutes 01 seconds East), a distance of 75.03 feet to a point for the North corner of this 0.224 acres, which bears North 30 degrees 44 minutes 40 seconds East from the center of a wooden fence post, same being the East corner of said Jimenez 0.12 acres and in the southwest Right-of-Way of said S. 3rd St.;

THENCE along the southwest Right-of-Way of said S. 3rd St., South 30 degrees 58 minutes 33 seconds East (called South 30 degrees 07 minutes 40 seconds East), a distance of 70.08 feet to the **POINT OF BEGINNING** and containing 0.224 acres of land, more or less.
