Dear Mr. Shumski:

The Montana Department of Health and Environmental Sciences (MDHES) Underground Storage Tank Program has reviewed information associated with a petroleum release at the above-referenced location. Based on the Limited Site Assessment report submitted by Delta Engineering, it appears that no further investigation or cleanup activities are needed. The residual contamination has weathered over time since the tanks were removed and is very low in the soils and below detection limits in the groundwater. Based on the available information, it does not appear that the very slight residual contamination is a hazard to human health or the environment.

The decision that no further corrective action is required is based on 2 site visits by Roxann Lincoln (DHES), a limited site assessment completed by Delta Engineering and soil and groundwater samples collected at the site.

The MDHES has removed your "leak file" from active status in the filing system. We will keep your file in a separate "resolved" section, so that if you need any information in the future or new problems with your site arise, then we can access the information easily.
