### ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

LAKE FOREST PROPERTY OWNERS ASSOCIATION, INC.

STATE OF ALABAMA COUNTY OF BALDWIN

The undersigned persons, being the Vice President, Secretary-Treasurer and Assistant Treasurer of an organization in the nature of a property owners association, do hereby, pursuant to and in accordance with the Code of Alabama, Title 10, Chapter 10, file these articles of incorporation with the Judge of Probate of Baldwin County, Alabama for the purpose of constituting this organization a body corporate under and pursuant to the laws of the State of Alabama.

### ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of the corporation shall be LAKE FOREST PROPERTY OWNERS ASSOCIATION, INC.

# ARTICLE II - DURATION

The duration of the corporation shall be perpetual, unless hereafter lawfully dissolved.

# ARTICLE III - PURPOSES

The purposes for which this corporation was formed are to devote itself to the improvement and civic betterment of the Lake Forest development in Baldwin County, Alabama, and to the operation, maintenance, management, ownership, buying, leasing, and handling of its common facilities, common areas, country club, marinas, recreational facilities, and guard and security service, to engage in any other business

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or activity permitted by law which may be useful or helpful in accomplishing any of the foregoing, and to engage in any other business or activity permitted by law for a non-profit corporation.

### ARTICLE IV - NON-PROFIT

This corporation shall be non-stock and non-profit and shall not afford pecuniary gain, incidentally or otherwise, to its members.

#### ARTICLE V- - MEMBERS

The membership of the corporation shall consist of two classes of members; one class of which shall be called Full Voting Members and the other class of which shall be called Associate Members.

Full Voting Members may vote for the election of directors and upon all other matters which require a vote of the membership. Associate Members may vote for the election of directors and upon all other matters concerning the country club and golf course which require a vote of the membership, but upon no other matters. Attached hereto, as Exhibit "A", is a list of the Associate Members.

Further requirements for membership and distinctions between the classes of members are set out in the By-Laws of the corporation.

The Board of Directors may from time to time create additional classes of members or modify the rules concerning existing classes by amendment of the By-Laws of the corporation.

## ARTICLE VI - LAKE FOREST DEVELOPMENT DEFINED

For the purposes of this instrument, the Lake Forest development shall be defined as encompassing all of the property

located in Baldwin County, Alabama, and which in the past was owned by Lake Forest, Inc., or may in the furture be owned by Lake Forest, Inc.; provided however, such future acquired property must be located within two miles of the property presently owned by Lake Forest, Inc.

## ARTICLE VII - DIRECTORS

The Board of Directors of the corporation shall consist of no less than three and no more than seven Directors, as may be established by the By-Laws, and who may or may not be members of the corporation. The term of office of such Directors shall be five years, or such other time as may be set out in the By-Laws. The initial Board of Directors, consisting of four directors, whose initial five year term of office shall begin upon the date of incorporation of the corporation, are:
