Education Impact Fees Approved March 5, 2024

Impact fees are a method of ensuring new or expanded development bears a portion of the financial burden to build or expand public infrastructure to accommodate the development.

We collect impact fees per **Florida Statute 163.31801**. The <u>transportation impact fee schedule</u> can be viewed as part of <u>county ordinance 15-14</u>.
