Darrell, the CRP contract applicable to those acres is a Grasslands CRP. This means that those acres are able to be grazed or hayed every year as long as the participant is following the grazing plan that was put in place with NRCS.

If the producer would want to terminate the CRP contract, someone would have to pay back the annual contract payment for every year it has been issued plus liquidated damages. For example this contract was approved in 2022 so the first payment would have been 2023, then a payment in 2024. So that would be \$18,988 that would have to be paid back plus liquidated damages which is 25% of the annual contract payment + interest on those payments that were made + any payments that were made on cost share.
