2. Information Collected and Consent

We do not sell your personal information: Under US State Privacy Laws, a business that sells personal information to others: 1) must give notice to that person before selling his/her personal information to others; and 2) must provide the right to opt-out of the sale of their personal information.

Your Rights Under US State Privacy Laws

1. Right to Access and Know: You may request that we disclose the following information:

- The categories of Personal Information we collected about you and the categories of sources from which we collected such Personal Information;
- The specific pieces of Personal Information we collected about you;
- The business or commercial purpose of collecting or sharing Personal Information about you;
- The categories of Personal Information about you that we shared (as defined under the applicable privacy law) and the categories of third parties with whom we shared such Personal Information; and
- The categories of Personal Information about you that we otherwise disclosed, and the categories of third parties to whom we disclosed such Personal Information (if applicable).

Under US State Privacy Laws, the right to obtain “specific pieces” does not grant a right to the whole of any document that contains Personal Information, but only the right to obtain items of your Personal Information. Additionally, you have a right to know “categories” of sources of Personal Information and “categories” of third parties to which personal information is disclosed, but not the individual sources or third parties. Sun does not always track individualized sources or recipients.

2. Right to Request Correction of your Personal Information: You may request to correct inaccuracies in your Personal Information;

3. Right to Request Deletion of Your Personal Information: You may request to have your Personal Information deleted;

4. Right to Opt-out of Sharing for Cross-Context Behavioral Advertising: You may request to opt out of the “sharing” of your Personal Information for purposes of cross-context behavioral advertising.

5. Right to Data Portability: You have the right to request a copy of your data in a machine-readable format.

Verification of Requests to Exercise Rights

When receiving a request, we will verify that the individual making the request is the resident to whom the Personal Information subject to the request pertains. You may exercise your rights yourself or may use an authorized agent to make requests to disclose certain information about the processing of your Personal Information or to delete Personal Information on your behalf. If you use an

authorized agent to submit a request, we may request that you provide us additional information demonstrating that the agent is acting on your behalf.

Categories of Personal Information We Collect

We collect information that identified you, your household or your device or is reasonably capable of being connected with or linked to you, your household, or your device. "Personal Information" does not include public information available from government records, de-identified or aggregated information, or information that is protected by certain laws such as HIPPA for health-related information and the Gramm-Leach Bliley Act for certain financial institutions.

How We Use Your Information

See above for how we use your information. We will not collect additional categories of personal information or use the personal information we collected for materially different, unrelated, or incompatible purposes without providing you notice.

We are not required to (1) retain your Personal Information if collected for a single one-time transaction if, in the ordinary course of business, that information would not be retained and (2) re-identify or otherwise link any data that, in the ordinary course of business, is not maintained in a way that would be considered personal information.

Request to Delete

We are not required to grant your deletion request if retaining the Personal Information is necessary for us or our service providers to:

1. Complete the transaction for which the Personal Information was collected, fulfill the terms of a written warranty or product recall, or otherwise perform a contract between us and you.
2. Detect security incidents, protect against malicious, deceptive, fraudulent, or illegal activity; or prosecute those responsible for that activity.
3. Debug to identify and repair errors that impact existing intended functionality.
4. Exercise free speech, ensure the right of another consumer to exercise that consumer's right of free speech, or exercise another right provided for by law.
5. Comply with the California Electronic Communications Privacy Act.
6. Engage in public or peer-reviewed scientific, historical, or statistical research in the public interest when the deletion of the public information is likely to render impossible or seriously impair the achievement of such research, if the consumer has provided informed consent.
7. For solely internal uses that are reasonably aligned with your expectations based on your relationship with us.
8. Comply with a legal obligation.
9. Internally make otherwise lawful uses of your Personal Information that are compatible with the context in which you provided your Personal Information.

Opt-Out Request

Once you make an opt-out request, we will wait at least twelve (12) months before asking you to reauthorize Personal Information sharing with third parties. However, you may change your mind and opt back into Personal Information sharing by re-submitting your information and providing applicable consent.

We will only use Personal Information provided in an opt-out request to review and comply with the request. We will act upon your opt-out request within 15 days of receipt.

Non-Discrimination

We will not discriminate against you for exercising any of your CCPA rights. Unless permitted by the CCPA, we will not:

- Deny you goods or services.
- Charge you different prices or rates for goods or services, including through granting discounts or other benefits, or imposing penalties.
- Provide you a different level or quality of goods or services.
- Suggest that you may receive a different price or rate for goods and services or a different level or quality of goods or services.

However, we may offer you certain financial incentives permitted by the CCPA that can result in different prices, rates, or quality levels. Any permitted financial incentive we offer will reasonably relate to your personal information's value and contain written terms that describe the program's material aspects. Participation in a financial incentive program requires your prior opt-in consent, which you may revoke at any time.

16. EU and UK Privacy Rights

This section is for users in the European Union and the United Kingdom (collectively, "EEA") and supplements the information contained in other sections of this policy and applies solely to all visitors, users and others who are located in the EEA. Any inconsistent terms in any other sections of this policy will be superseded by this Section for EEA residents.

- **Personal Data.** References to Personal Information in this policy are equivalent to "personal data" governed by the General Data Protection Regulation (EU/UK) (collectively and generically, the "GDPR").
- **Controller.** We are the controller of your Personal Information covered by this policy for purposes of the GDPR. Our contact information is provided below.
- **Legal Bases for Processing.** We use your Personal Information only as permitted by law. Our legal bases for processing Personal Information is described in this Section 14 as follows:
 - To provide Services to you.
 - To perform our contractual obligations.
 - To perform pre-contractual measures.
 - For research and development.
 - To send you marketing communications.
 - For compliance, fraud prevention and safety.
 - To create anonymous data.
 - To comply with applicable law.
 - Processing of Personal Data with your consent.
 - Protect your vital interests or those of another natural person.
 - Processing operations that are pursued by Sun Communities for our legitimate interests or by a third party, except where such interests are overridden by the interests or fundamental rights and freedoms of the data subject which require protection of Personal Data.
- **Your rights.** The GDPR gives you certain rights regarding your personal data. If you are located within the EEA, you may ask us to take the following actions in relation to your Personal Information that we hold:
 - **Right to Access.** You have the right to request information about our processing of your Personal Data and give you access to your Personal Data. In addition, you also have the right to know the following information:

- the purposes of the processing;
 - the categories of Personal Data concerned;
 - the recipients or categories of recipients to whom the Personal Data have been or will be disclosed, recipients in third countries or international organizations;
 - where possible, the envisaged period for which the Personal Data will be stored, or, if not possible, the criteria used to determine that period;
 - the existence of the right to request from the data controller rectification or erasure of Personal Data, or restriction of processing of Personal Data concerning you, or to object to such processing;
 - the existence of the right to lodge a complaint with the Information Commissioner's Office which is the UK's data protection regulator;
 - where the Personal Data is not collected from you, any available information as to their source;
 - the existence of automated decision-making, including profiling, and, at least in those cases, meaningful information about the logic involved, as well as the significance and envisaged consequences of such processing for you.
- **Right to Rectification.** You have the right to update or correct inaccuracies in your Personal Data. Taking into account the purposes of the processing, you shall have the right to have incomplete personal data completed, including by means of providing a supplementary statement.
 - **Right to Erasure ("Right to be Forgotten").** You have the right to request that Personal Data be deleted without undue delay where one of the following grounds applies, if the processing is not necessary:
 - The Personal Data is no longer necessary in relation to the purposes for which they were collected or otherwise processed.
 - You withdraw Consent to which the processing is based according to point (a) of Article 6(1) of the GDPR, or point (a) of Article 9(2) of the GDPR, and where there is no other legal ground for the processing.
 - You object to the processing pursuant to Article 21(1) of the GDPR and there are no overriding legitimate grounds for the processing, or you object to the processing pursuant to Article 21(2) of the GDPR.
 - The Personal Data has been unlawfully processed.
 - The Personal Data must be erased for compliance with a legal obligation in UK law to which the data controller is subject.
 - The Personal Data has been collected in relation to the offer of information society services directly to a child, referred to in Article 8(1) of the GDPR.
 - **Right to Restrict Processing.** You have the right to restrict the processing of your Personal Data where one of the following applies:
 - The accuracy of the Personal Data is contested by you, for a period enabling us to verify the accuracy of the Personal Data.
 - The processing is unlawful, and you oppose the erasure of the Personal Data and request the restriction of their use instead.
 - We no longer need the Personal Data for the purposes of the contemplated processing but is required by us to exercise or defend legal claims.
 - You have objected to processing pursuant to Article 21(1) of the GDPR pending the verification whether our legitimate grounds of processing override those of yours.
 - **Right to Data Portability.** You have the right to receive your Personal Data, which was provided to us, in a structured, commonly used machine-readable format.
 - You shall have the right to transmit such Personal Data to another controller without hindrance from us, as long as the processing is based on consent pursuant to point (a) of Article 6(1) of the GDPR or point (a) of Article 9(2) of the

GDPR, or on a contract pursuant to point (b) of Article 6(1) of the GDPR, and the processing is carried out by automated means, as long as the processing is not necessary for the performance of a task carried out in the public interest or in the exercise of official authority vested in the controller.

- In exercising your right to data portability pursuant to Article 20(1) of the GDPR, you shall have the right to have Personal Data transmitted directly from one controller to another, where technically feasible and when doing so does not adversely affect the rights and freedoms of others.
- **Right to Object/Withdraw Consent.** You have the right to object to our reliance on our legitimate interests as the basis of our processing of your Personal Information that impacts your rights. You also have the right to withdraw your consent to our processing of your Personal Data at anytime.
- **Right Not to Be Subject to Automated Decision Making.** You have the right to object to decisions based solely on automated processing, including profiling, which produces legal effects concerning you or affecting you.
- **Cross-Border Data Transfer.** Personal data voluntarily submitted to us online, via electronic communication, or otherwise, may be maintained or accessed in servers or files in the United States, which the European Union and UK have not deemed to provide “adequate” privacy protection. If you do not consent to having your personal data processed and stored in the United States, please do not provide it to us on the Website or through any other means.

Sun contends that the General Data Protection Regulation (EU) 2016/679 does not apply to its processing of Personal Information and that it is not within the jurisdiction of the EU. All processing of PII is governed by the applicable laws of the United States of America.

Unless otherwise provided for under applicable privacy law, only you, or someone legally authorized to act on your behalf, may make a verifiable request to your Personal Information. Unless otherwise provided for in applicable privacy law, we are not required to provide you with Personal Information more than twice in a 12-month period.

We will not be able to respond to your request to provide you with Personal Information if we cannot verify your identity or authority to make the request and confirm the Personal Information relates to you or someone you are authorized to request and receive the Personal Information on behalf of.

Unless legally obligated to respond in a shorter timeframe, we will try to respond to your request within forty-five (45) days of receipt of your written request. If we require more time (up to 90 days), we will inform you of the extension period in writing. We will deliver our written response by mail or electronically, at your option. Any disclosures we provide will only cover the 12-month period preceding the verifiable consumer request's receipt. The response we provide will also explain the reasons we cannot comply with a request, if applicable. For data portability requests, we will select a format to provide your personal information that is readily useable and should allow you to transmit the information from one entity to another entity without hindrance, specifically by electronic mail communication.

We may request specific information from you to help us confirm your identity and process your request. Applicable law may require or permit us to decline your request. If we decline your request, we will tell you why, subject to legal restrictions.

Appeals for U.S. Residents: If you are a resident in a state that provides any of the rights set forth in Section 15 and Sun has refused to take action on your request related to any of the above specified rights or any other privacy related request, you may appeal Sun's refusal under the Privacy Policy section of our website at www.suninc.com, filling out the form and submitting it to us. We will inform you in writing of any action taken or not taken in response to your appeal within sixty (60) days of receiving your appeal. Our response will include a written explanation of the reason or reasons for our decision. If we deny your appeal, you may contact the attorney general in your state to file a complaint.
